## Project Update: We're closing part of Station Road for 5 weeks

Kia ora,

We are moving into the next phase of our work to upgrade Station Road to serve the growing community around Huapai Triangle Special Housing Area.

For this next phase, our contractor Fulton Hogan will be rebuilding the 200-metre stretch of Station Road beginning at State Highway 16 and ending just before Schoolside Road. To complete this work, we will need to fully close this section of Station Road for about five weeks beginning Thursday, 16 May 2024.

<b>Where</b>	Station Road between SH16 and Schoolside Road
<b>When (start date)</b>	Thursday, 16 May
<b>Hours</b>	24/7 road closure. Working hours will be from 7am to 7pm.
<b>Duration</b>	5 weeks (estimated)

### The work we're doing.

We're implementing a full road closure for this stage due to the extensive nature of the works. Because the existing road width is so narrow and confined, a full closure will allow our construction crews the necessary room to carry out their work excavating the existing road and building the new, wider road safely, as well as sufficient space to move their large vehicles and equipment. A full road closure will also allow crews to complete a wider range of tasks more efficiently, resulting in reduced construction time.

The full scope of work will involve:

- Digging out to make the road wider and to add a cycleway and parking bays
- Installing new stormwater drainage channels
- Building up the new cycleway
- Installing a thick concrete subbase for the new road
- Installing a new kerb and channel
- Installing six new driveways
- Paving the final asphalt surfacing for the new road

### Traffic management and detours

- Residents will still be able to access their properties throughout the road closure.
- Emergency services vehicles will be able to access the road in an emergency.



- For everyone else, please follow the detour routes as shown in the diagrams below. We'll also post traffic signs along the surrounding roads that give directions.
- Please take care when driving through the area. Follow all detour signs, signals, and directions by our traffic management teams. Plan ahead and allow extra time to reach your destination.
- The traffic management crew onsite will be available to assist drivers and other travellers throughout the road closure.
- We'll do our best to start the work on time and complete it as quickly as possible. Factors such as wet weather could mean delays. If the delay is significant, we'll notify the community immediately.
