We are upgrading the footpath and installing zebra crossings to improve safety on Kaipara Coast Highway in Kaukapakapa. Work will take place between 7 September and 11 December 2026 from 7am to 5pm. These works are part of the Kaukapakapa Footpath Connections project within the Rodney Local Board Transport Targeted Rate Programme. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

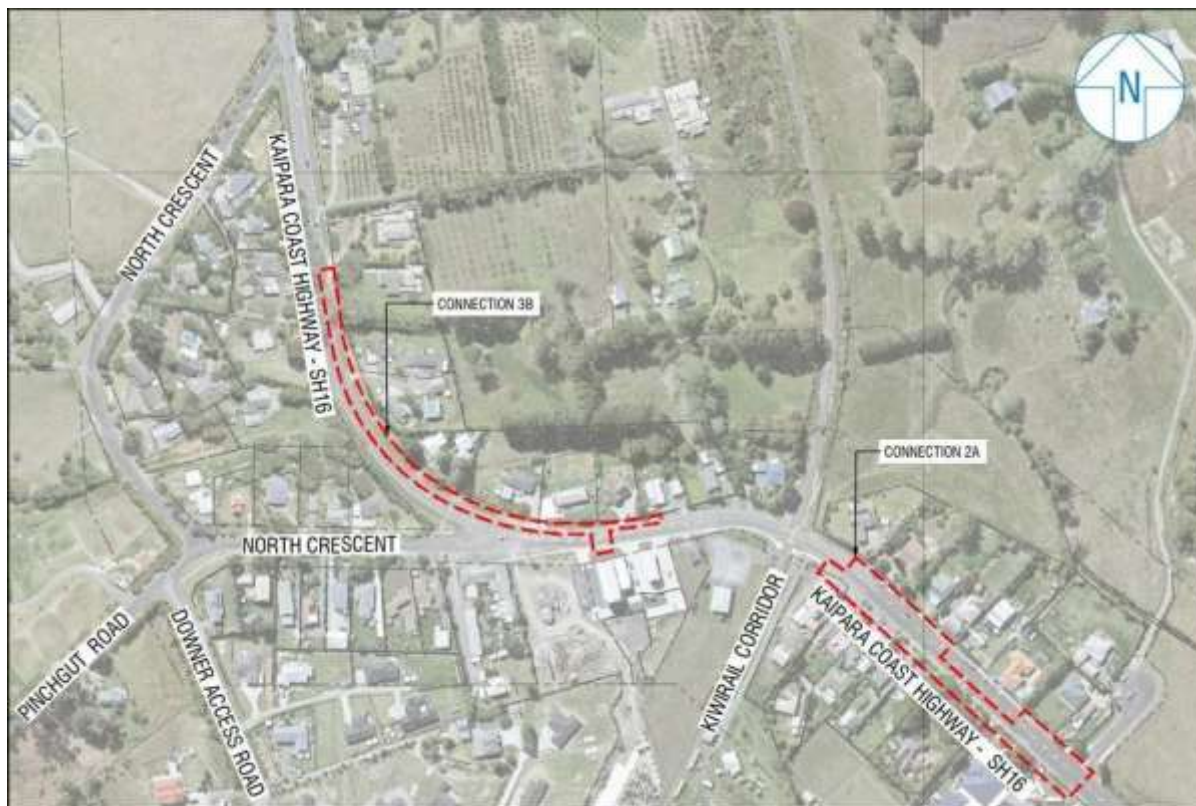


Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Between numbers 945 and 1105 Kaipara Coast Highway in Kaukapakapa (see work location map below).
When	- Between 7 September and 11 December 2026 from 7am to 5pm. - Please know that some nightworks will be carried out. Residents and businesses will be notified of these works in advance, closer to the time they take place.
What we're doing	- Installing a new zebra crossing (at-grade pedestrian crossing). - Widening existing footpaths. - Reconstructing driveways. - Realigning car parks to improve visibility onto SH16.
How it may impact you	- Parking outside the Kaukapakapa Village shops will be impacted during works. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property. - Works will create noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise levels down. - Noisy and disruptive work adjacent to shops will be carried out at night.
How travel is affected	- Lanes on Kaipara Coast Highway will be reduced. - Traffic on Kaipara Coast Highway will be managed with a Stop/Go sign system. Please follow all signs. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.
