Work Notification - road maintenance and improvements along Merton Road, St Johns

Kia ora,

We'd like to let you know about the upcoming road maintenance and improvement work along Merton Road between Morrin and College Road, St Johns. Downer will be carrying out these works on behalf of Auckland Transport (AT).

The work we're doing

What we'll be doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Footpath, kerb & channel works - Resurfacing the road with new asphalt and line marking - Installation of cycle separators
Where	<p>Merton Road, St Johns</p> <p>Between Morrin Road and College Road, St Johns, Auckland</p> <p>The drawings overleaf show where we'll be working. Work area is indicative.</p>
When (start date)	<p>Monday 4 May 2026</p> <p>Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.</p>
Hours of work	7am to 7pm
For (duration)	Up to 3 months
What to expect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Works will be undertaken on the northern side of Merton Road, commencing near Merton Reserve and progressing in stages towards College Road. This staged approach is designed to minimise disruption and maintain parking where possible. • Pedestrian detours will be in place around the works zone. • On-street parking will be reduced in and around the work area. 24 hours prior to works starting 'no parking' cones will be installed to provide notice. • Traffic flow will be maintained in both directions along Merton Road; side roads may have temporary detours in place. • If work is required on your driveway that impacts vehicle access such as a concrete pour, a member of our team will contact you. Pedestrian access to properties will be always maintained. • Bus stops may be temporarily relocated, please check AT journey planner for up-to-date information.

Temporary Traffic Management

Traffic flow will be maintained along Merton Road throughout the works. To allow construction activities to be completed safely at intersections, temporary detours will be in place for side street access at various stages. When these detours are implemented, no-parking restrictions will also be installed along detour routes due to the narrow street widths, ensuring sufficient space for vehicle movements and maintaining safe traffic flow.

You'll need to reduce your speed when you're driving through the area. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions in place.

Road Resurfacing Works

Following the completion of these works, the road will be resurfaced. Resurfacing works are required to be done at night; we know this work can be loud and disruptive and wherever possible we aim to schedule the noisiest work earlier in the evening. As part of these works, we will be completing the final stages of the Links to G1 project and installing cycle separators. Further notification on the timing and duration of resurfacing and final project works will be shared closer to the start date.
