Road Works Notice

Links to Glen Innes Cycleways Project and Road Maintenance

Our contractor Downer are set to start work in Line Road in the Glen Innes Town Centre.

Where	Line Road – from the Line Road / Taniwha Street Roundabout up to West Tamaki Road, Glen Innes
When	6th January 2025 We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.
Hours of Work	We will be working a combination of day and night shifts - Monday to Saturday, the closure will remain 24hrs.
Duration	Stage 1: Phase 1 approx. 5 weeks (one side of the roundabout) Phase 2 approx. 3 weeks (opposite side of the roundabout) Stage 2: approx. 6 weeks (the roundabout to Eastview Road) Details on the remaining stages will follow at a later date.

The work we're doing

We will deliver routine road maintenance and renewal work alongside the Links to GI cycleway project. The upgrade works in this section include:

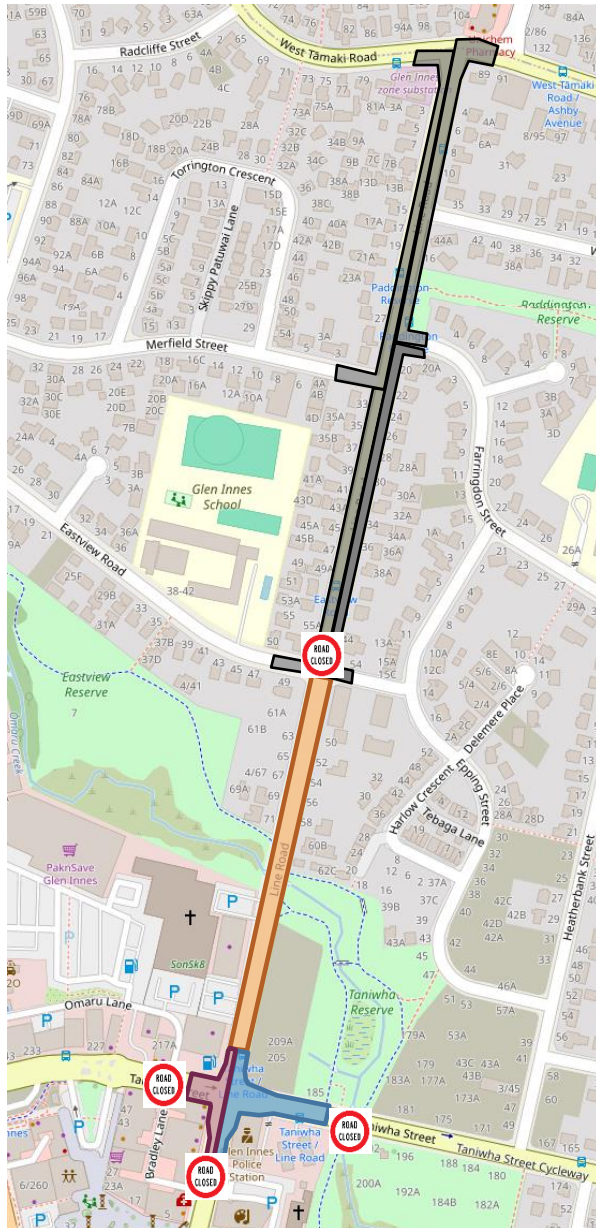
- Adding a cycleway
- Installing raised speed tables
- Reconstructing the Line Road/Taniwha Street Roundabout
- Replacing streetlights
- Installing new drainage
- Traffic Island replacement
- Bus stop upgrades
- Footpath, vehicle crossing, kerb and channel renewals

These upgrades will improve the safety of pedestrians and cyclists traveling along Line Road and make it more accessible for people who are catching public transport.

Traffic Management

There will be sectional road closures in place while we carry out the works. We do this to keep traffic moving, parking available, and to keep people who use the roads and footpaths safe.

On-street parking will be limited while we carry out the work. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property.

Stage 1: Line Road/Taniwha Street Roundabout

Half Roundabout Closure

Phase 1: Approx. 5 weeks

Phase 2: Approx. 3 weeks

Stage 2: Taniwha Street to Eastview Road

Road Closure (Access will remain for residents and businesses)

Approx. 6 weeks

Eastview Road to West Tamaki Road will follow directly after stage 2 is complete.

Once the dates and durations are confirmed for the remaining stages we will be in touch.

- Please note once each stage is complete, our team will pack up and move down to the next phase while opening the footpath for pedestrians to access.
