Improving road safety & visibility on your street

Kia ora,

Auckland Transport have received requests from residents of Kingfisher Place to address access issues caused by on street parking.

To improve access for residents, and service providers such as rubbish collection and emergency services. We're planning to mark existing four angled car parking spaces in the cul-de-sac and paint broken yellow lines (no stopping at all times) to clearly designate no parking zones.

The changes we're making by March 2025 and the changes will include:

- Installing broken yellow lines (no stopping at all times) to sections of Kingfisher Place
- To prohibit parking on grass berm
- Formalise four angled parking spaces located in the cul de sac

Please refer to the drawing on the next page to see where these changes apply.

In good weather conditions, it will take one day to paint the broken yellow lines. We know this may cause an inconvenience, and we've tried to minimise this as much as possible.

Vehicles parked illegally on the new broken yellow lines may receive infringement notices or be towed away.

Benefits to your neighbourhood

- Clears congestion and ensures ease of access for all vehicles into and out of Kingfisher Road including waste removal and emergency services.
- Improves visibility for drivers to see oncoming cars, people walking, cycling, and crossing the road, making it safer for all road users.
- Prevents vehicles damaging berms and potential damage to underground utilities
