We're making footpath renewals for increased pedestrian safety in Birkenhead Town Centre

Kia ora,

We are making footpath renewals to Birkenhead Avenue, to improve pedestrian safety in Birkenhead. The work involves renewing existing pavers on the eastern side of Birkenhead Avenue, which includes footpath tiles and tactile pavers (yellow anti-slip surfacing).

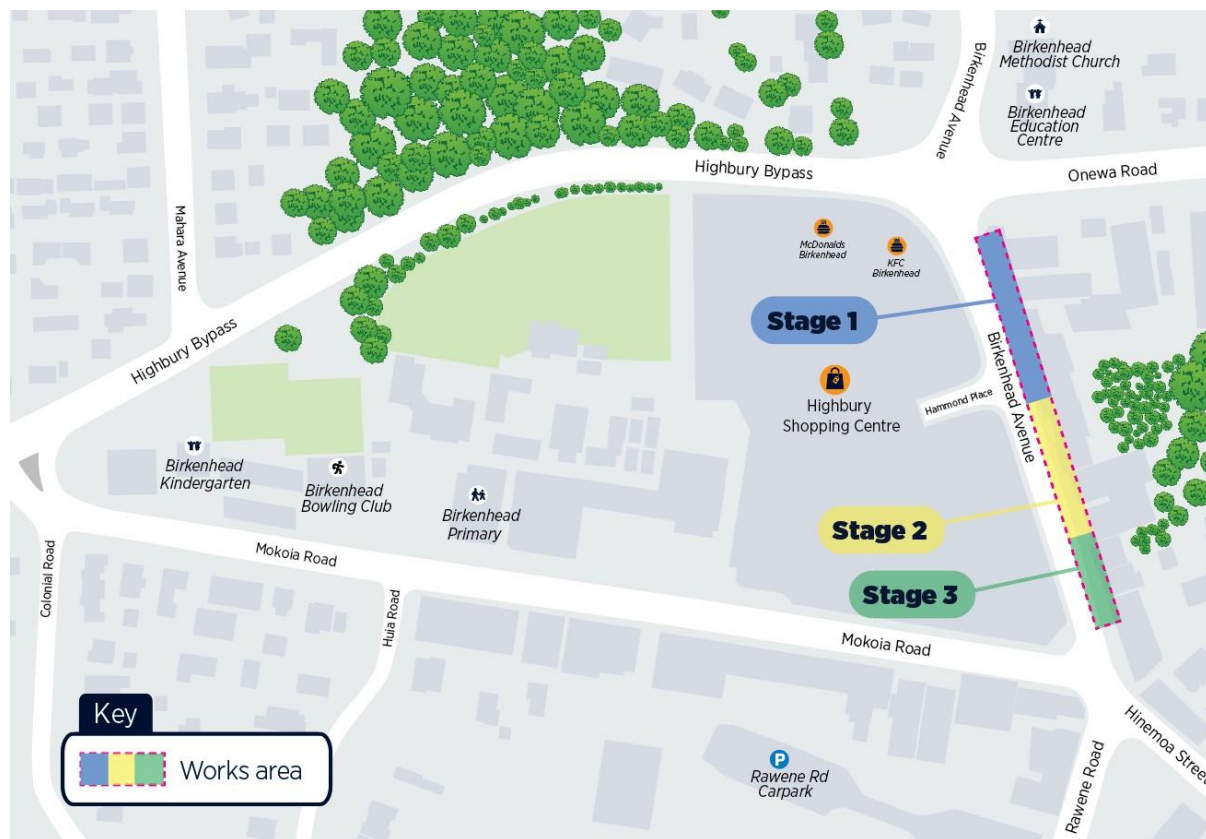
This work will take place between Sunday 24 May to early September 2026, over a combination of days and nights. This work is part of the Birkenhead Town Centre Paver Renewal project, with the support from the Local Board Transport Capital Fund programme.

Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you. Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between numbers 15 and 85 Birkenhead Avenue in Birkenhead (see work location map on the overleaf)
When	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Between Sunday 24 May to early September 2026, both day and at night:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dayworks: 7am to 6pm Nightworks: 8pm to 6am
What we're doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Renewing all pavers within the eastern side of Birkenhead Avenue, in Birkenhead Town Centre
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On-street parking will be limited at night, with some occupied during day shifts. You may need to park nearby and walk to continue your journey.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eastern side road shoulder will be closed at night on Birkenhead Ave, with no impacts to road traffic journeys. Minimal parking will be repurposed for equipment during the day. Footpath access will be maintained around our works. Pedestrian access into stores will be maintained during business hours. Bus Stop 3901 – Highbury Shops will be closed for the first week of construction and relocated nearby. The AT Mobile app will share notifications about route changes and stops nearby. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions. Driveway crossings will be temporarily affected, but contractors will liaise with you in advance

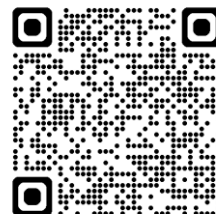
Work location
