Funding of this project will be subject to assessing the implications of the removal of Regional Fuel Tax on AT's overall capital programme. <b>Update 20 May 2024:</b> The Whangaparaoa bus station has been included in the draft LTP at a total cost of \$32.6m. The project is also prioritised near the middle of the overall RLTP project prioritisation list. Significant uncertainty remains about the capacity for NZTA to fund the NLTF share.
