We're making improvements to the Brighton Road and Bassett Road intersection in Remuera

Kia ora,

We are upgrading the Brighton Road and Bassett Road intersection in Remuera to improve road safety for all road users. Work will take place over two full weekends (Friday 15 May – Monday 18 May and Friday 22 May – Monday 25 May) along with some weeknights, overnight. These works are part of the Brighton Road & Shore Road and Bassett Road Intersection Improvements project within the Road Safety programme. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intersection of Brighton Road, Shore Road and Bassett Road in Remuera (see works location map in overleaf)
When	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Works will take place overnight between 7pm and 5am on the following days: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ First weekend: 15 May to 18 May ○ Second weekend: 22 May to 25 May ○ Weeknights: between 18 May and 22 May <p>Note: Further work will take place to carry out high friction road resurfacing mid-June 2026. We will notify you closer to the time.</p>
What we're doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We're installing the following road safety improvements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ New mid-block signalised crossing ○ New zebra crossing ○ New speed table ○ Footpath and kerb and channel upgrades ○ New road marking and signage
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Roads will be closed on both weekends. If you live along closed roads, traffic controllers will help you access your property. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions. • During weeknight works, traffic will be managed with a Stop/Go sign system. • Works will create noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise levels down.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detours will be in place to redirect traffic around the work site. For Brighton Road closure, cars will detour through Ayr Street, Parnell Road, St Stephens Avenue, Gladstone Road and Canterbury Place while for Bassett Road closure, cars can detour through Shore Road and Seaview Road. • Alternative bus stops will be in place as stops 7660 – Kenderdine Street, 7667 – Kenderdine Street, 7662 – Lee Street and 7669 Lee Street will be closed.
