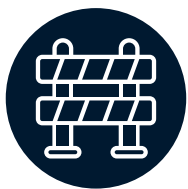


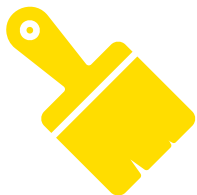

## In short



We're working at the Line Road and Taniwha Street roundabout. Once completed we'll move down Line Road.



We've resurfaced and painted new road markings along Stonefields Avenue and Morrin Road. Next up is installation of cycling separators.



The crew have completed the resurfacing and remarking of the Mayfair Place carpark.



We're currently planning traffic management for the Apirana Avenue, Tripoli Road and Pilkington Road roundabout upgrades.



## Line Road & Taniwha Street Roundabout

We started the New Year by beginning the final stretch of the Links to GI cycle network.

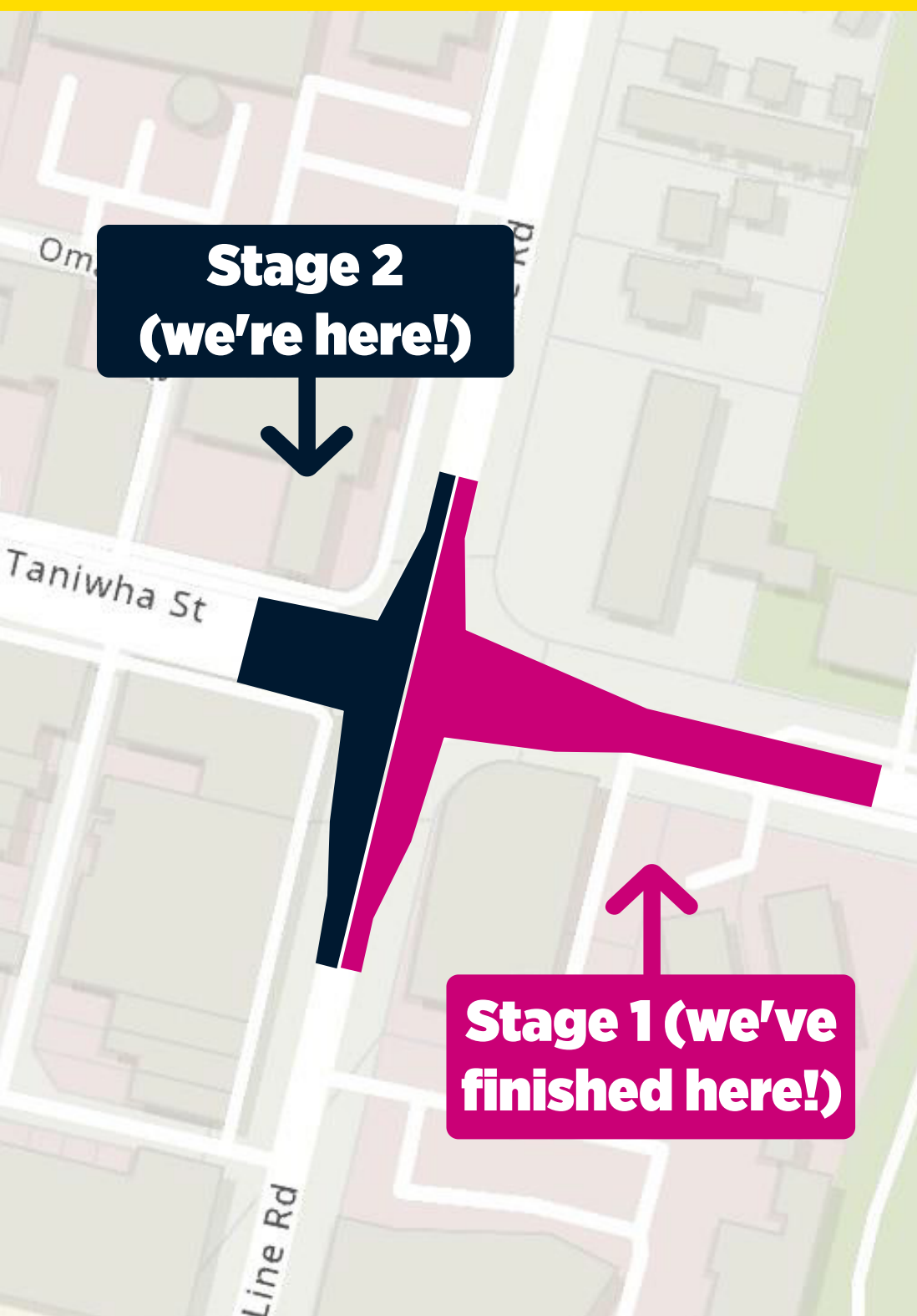
We're currently working on new pedestrian and cyclist crossings at the Line Road & Taniwha Street roundabout.

We've split the roundabout upgrades into two stages to keep traffic flowing, targeting completion this month.





## Key information about the Line Road & Taniwha Street roundabout works



We anticipate stage 2 will take approximately 3 weeks.

To access the Glen Innes Bike Hub, please enter Taniwha Street via Heatherbank Street.

On-street parking will be limited. You may need to park on your property, or on a side road and walk to your property.

We will maintain access to businesses on Line Road.



## Line Road & Taniwha Street Roundabout Stage 2 Progress

On the western half of the roundabout, our crew has completed the majority of the preparation and underground works including excavation and drainage works.

Great progress has also been made on the new concrete cycleway, crossings and footpaths.

Once we've upgraded both sides of the roundabout our works will shift Line Road towards West Tamaki Drive.

## Stonefields Ave and Morrin Road

The crew completed resurfacing and painting road markings at the Morrin Road roundabout, Morrin Road slip lane, and Stonefields Avenue.

These works are the “icing” part of the road cake, and marks the completion of the physical works at these locations.

These upgrades support more sustainable and healthy transport choices for people commuting to work, visiting the Auckland Netball Club, and the Sunday Markets.

- **When?** February – March 2025.
- **Why?** To support new Links to GI cycling network connecting locals to the Glen Innes Train station.

We plan to install cycle separators and plants along **Morrin Road and Stonefields Avenue.**

- **When?** February 2025
- **Why?** Separators protect the cyclists from vehicles and vegetation helps to filter rainwater and beautify the neighbourhood.
