We're doing remedial works around the Taniwha Street roundabout

Kia ora,

We need to return to the Taniwha Street roundabout and Bradley Lane to complete remedial works, we will begin these works on **Friday 3, April** over approximately two weeks.

Please note that wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay the start or completion of the works. If there are significant delays, we will keep you informed.

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Taniwha Street/Line Road roundabout & Bradley Lane, Glen Innes
When	Friday 3, April from 7am to 7pm for approximately 2 weeks
What we're doing	Remedial works to Taniwha Street roundabout and kerb line improvements on Bradley Lane to accommodate delivery truck movements.
How it may impact you	<p>Works will be delivered in two stages to minimise disruption:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stage 1: Taniwha Street, Line Road & Bradley Lane - Stage 2: Taniwha Street & Line Road <p>Road closures will be in place during the works, and delivery vehicles, taxis, and ride-share services may need to use alternative routes.</p>
How travel is affected	<p>Traffic management will be in place 24/7 during these works to allow the concrete to cure properly before vehicles can drive over it.</p> <p>On-street parking will be limited during working hours. "No Parking" signs will be installed 24 hours before works begin to provide advance notice and will only be used where required.</p> <p>Traffic controllers will be onsite to assist drivers and pedestrians around the work area. Please refer to the traffic management plans over the page for more detail. Please follow all signs, light signals, and directions from our traffic management team, and allow extra time for your travel.</p> <p>Bus stops will be temporarily relocated, please check the AT Mobile app for up-to-date information.</p>

Following these works we will be resurfacing Line Road and the roundabout; this work is completed at night; we understand these works are disruptive and try to complete the louder works earlier in the evening. We will provide further notification prior to these works.
