We've considered your feedback. What's happening next?

Improving parking availability on Purewa Road, Meadowbank

Kia ora,

In June 2026, you shared your views on our proposal to improve parking availability and better manage parking demand for residents, commuters, and visitors to the Ōrākei Basin and Meadowbank train station by introducing time restrictions on some angled parking spaces on Purewa Road.

We'd like to thank you for taking the time to share your thoughts on the proposed changes.

After carefully considering the feedback received from residents, we've made minor changes to the original design to better address community concerns.

What's changed?

- Reduced the number of restricted parking spaces from **nine to four** outside 3 Purewa Road.
- Changed the operating days for the proposed time restrictions outside 3 Purewa Road and opposite 9 Purewa Road from Monday to Sunday to Monday to Friday.

We now plan to deliver the following:

- **Outside 3 Purewa Road**

Install P120 (2-hour) time restrictions on **four parking spaces**, from 8am to 6pm, **Monday to Friday**. This will provide short-term parking for contractors and visitors in the area.

- **Opposite 9 Purewa Road**

Install P4 Hours (P240 minutes) time restrictions on three parking spaces, from 8am to 6pm, **Monday to Friday**. This will provide medium-term parking to better support some commuters.

What happens next

We aim to implement these changes by December 2026.
