We're upgrading the footpath and installing zebra crossings on Kaipara Coast Highway in Kaukapakapa

Kia ora,

We are upgrading the footpath and installing zebra crossings to improve safety on Kaipara Coast Highway in Kaukapakapa. Work will take place between 8 June and 30 September 2026 with day and night shifts.

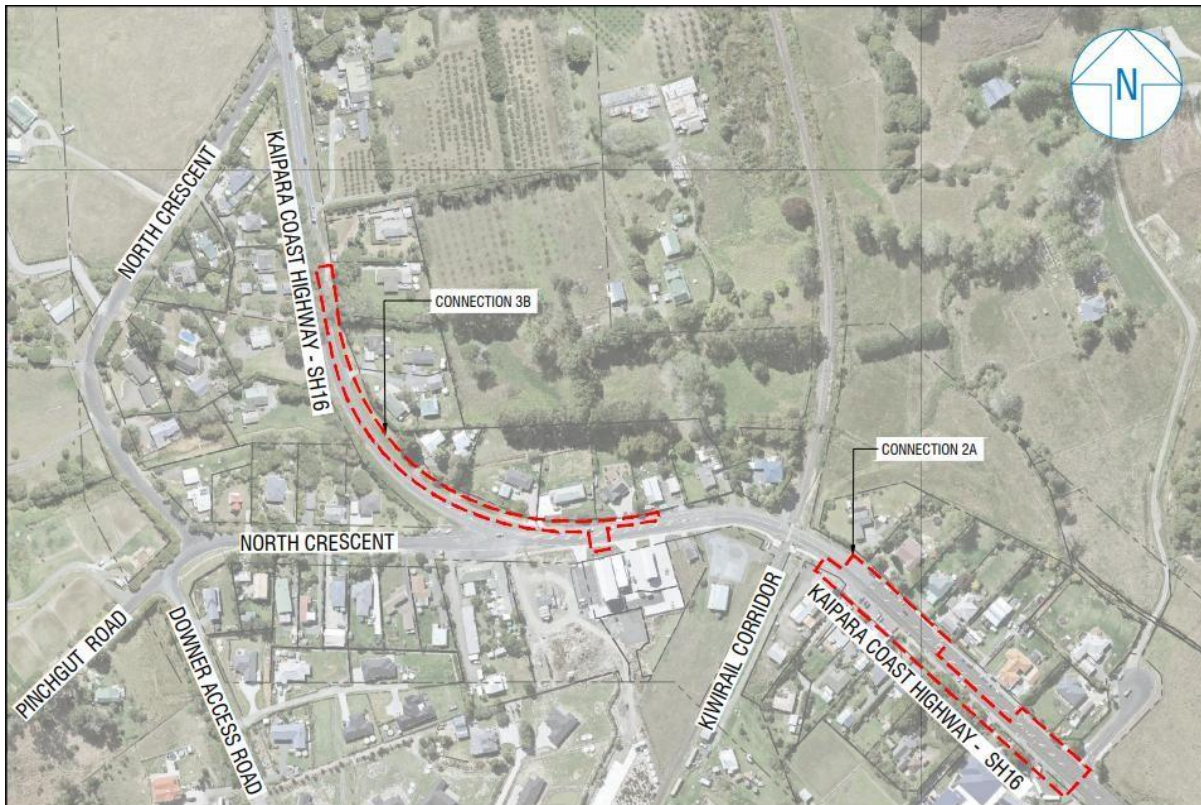
Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between numbers 945 and 1105 Kaipara Coast Highway in Kaukapakapa (see work location map below)
When	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between Monday 8 June and 30 September 2026 with day and night shifts.
What we're doing	<p>The Footpath Connection project includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Redesigned and improved footpaths, with areas widened and new driveway entries within the busy Kaukapakapa township. Improved safety and sightlines for people on foot, while crossing the road and connecting you to local amenities from side roads and SH16. We listened and removed raised crossings from the project, using zebra crossings instead. Realigning car parks to improve drivers' visibility and safety while reversing onto SH16.
How it may impact you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parking outside the Kaukapakapa Village shops will be impacted during works. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property. Works will create noise and vibration; we'll do our best to keep noise levels down. Noisy and disruptive work adjacent to shops will be carried out at night. Works near the school are to be undertaken during Term 2 school holidays.
How travel is affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lanes on Kaipara Coast Highway will be reduced. Traffic on Kaipara Coast Highway will be managed with a Stop/Go sign system. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions. <p>Traffic controllers will be on site to assist around the work site.</p>
