We're improving stormwater on Carrington Road, Mount Albert

Kia ora,

Following stormwater investigations completed in late August, we are starting the next stage of main works from 14 September to 10 October 2026. This work is part of the Carrington Road Improvements project. Future stages may affect you, and we will provide updates before those works begin.

Unexpected site conditions or wet weather may cause delays. If there is a significant delay, we will let you know. Scan the QR code for more information about the project, or subscribe to our newsletter for future updates, including targeted construction communications about upcoming stages.



Here is what you need to know about the work near you:

Where	Segar Avenue and Carrington Road intersection, and Carrington Road between properties 78 and 98 Carrington Road, Mount Albert
When	14 September to 10 October 2026
What we're doing	Installing a new stormwater line.
How it may impact you	Property access: Work will start at the Segar Avenue and Carrington Road intersection, then progress along Carrington Road driveway by driveway from property number 78 through to property number 98. Vehicle access will be limited during working hours when we are working across driveways. <u>Dempsey Wood has contacted affected property owners directly and will let each property know the day before we need to cross your driveway.</u> You will need to park on a side street during this time. Pedestrian access to properties will be maintained. Noise and vibration: Some noise and vibration is expected. We will monitor this and keep disruption as low as practicable.
How travel is affected	Segar Avenue road closure from 14 September for approximately two weeks: Segar Avenue will be closed at Carrington Road 24/7 during this work. Access will be via Rawalpindi Street at all times. Tasman Avenue left-in/left-out from 1 October for approximately one week: Tasman Avenue will operate as left-in, left-out only at all times during this stage of work, including during and outside working hours. Please follow signs and traffic management for everyone's safety. Pedestrian access: Pedestrian access will remain open. Please follow signs for any temporary detours.
