

# Merton Road Upgrades

The Merton Road upgrades are part of the Links to Glen Innes Cycleway project that aims to create more options for people to travel safely and sustainably in our growing communities.



## What you need to know



Upgrades to Merton Road will complete the **final, key cycle link to the heart of Glen Innes**, unlocking more opportunities for locals to visit the shops, sporting destinations, or to catch the train!



Road maintenance and construction on Merton Road, between the Morrin Road and Apirana Avenue roundabouts, is anticipated to start on **15 September 2025. We expect to complete this work overnight, in approximately 12 weeks.**



Following feedback from the Ōrākei Local Board, as well as a change in design standards, **we are taking time to review parts of the Merton Road design.**

We now plan to paint pedestrian and cyclist crossings on all approaches of the Morrin, Merton, and Felton Matthew Road roundabout.

We're looking at different design options for the cycleway along Merton Road, between College Road and Morrin Road.

We're reviewing the Merton, Apirana, Line and Pt England Road roundabout following a change in design standards for arterial roads.
