Construction is here!

We recently marked an exciting milestone on the Carrington Road Improvement project with a sod-turning event where local representatives and project partners joined AT to recognise, and celebrate the start of construction. Thank you to everyone who joined us, work is now underway!

June 2026

Enabling works will commence 2 June to prepare the site for the full construction phase. The project will be delivered until early-mid 2028. Work will mostly take place during the day with nights also required at periods throughout.

Project background

This work is funded by the Government through the Infrastructure Acceleration fund and is managed by National Infrastructure Funding and Financing (NIFF)

Auckland Transport is upgrading essential services on Carrington Road on behalf of project partners to support local housing development and improve access and safety along this key transport corridor connecting Point Chevalier and Mount Albert town centres.

Over the next 10 to 15-plus years, at least 4,000 homes will be built in the area around Unitec campus. Te Kukūnga Waka (Carrington Residential Development) will increase the number of people using Carrington Road and change how it is used and accessed.

Carrington Road is a vital route used to access: - Bus and train services - State Highway 16 - Northwestern Cycleway - Local homes, businesses, education providers and surrounding suburbs. The corridor is 1.6 Km long and carries approximately 15,000 vehicles per day.
